

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

CHECK PAYMENT

The deposit of \$500/person is due with the reservation form, plus the optional travel insurance payment (if applicable). The second and third payment of \$2500 and \$1999 are due on March 1 and June 1, 2022. All payments must be in the form of a check made payable to Siouxland Travel. We do not accept credit cards as a form of payment for this tour.

HEALTH, PASSPORT AND INSURANCE

Tour participants are completely responsible for their own well-being and fitness prior and during the tour and should receive their physician's approval to engage in the tour. Participants must be in the possession of a valid passport (must be valid until at least March 18, 2023). If you have been convicted of a felony in the last 5 years or if you have a DUI offense on your record, you may need to request special permission to enter Canada. Please talk to one of our agents for further details.

RELEASE AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK

DAILY ITINERARY

SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 10

Motorcoach transfer with your Siouxland Travel Representative to our designated airport. Fly to Calgary and meet our private motorcoach transfer to the hotel. Free time to explore this afternoon and the option to enjoy the Calgary Tower with stellar views from 525 feet above the city (admission included). A special welcome dinner is planned for tonight. (B,D)

SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 11

Enjoy a hot breakfast before boarding the motorcoach for our transfer to Banff including a full day of sightseeing. Highlights include the Hoodoos rock formations, Surprise Corner and Tunnel Mountain Drive. Discover how the West was won at Canada's largest living history museum. Lunch is included at the Heritage Park Historical Village. Also we will enjoy the Banff Gondola as we ascend Sulphur Mountain in a record-breaking eight minutes and get a bird's-eye view of six mountain ranges. Upon arrival to Banff National Park, we will check into our mountain lodge hotel, our home for the next two nights. (B,L,D)

MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 12

After breakfast we will board our private motorcoach for a full day tour along the magnificent Icefields Parkway. This icefield is one of the largest accumulations of ice south of the Arctic Circle. We will tour the Athabasca Glacier in a giant six-wheel drive Ice Explorer while learning of its ancient history and unique geological features. We will also take a stroll on the Glacier Skywalk which takes spectacular scenery and a rare view of nature to unbelievable new heights. (B,L)

TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 13

Enjoy a hot breakfast this morning before heading out for our full-day tour of Banff and Yoho National Park. We will admire magnificent natural wonders like the Spiral Tunnels, the turquoise serene waters of Emerald Lake and a natural Rock Bridge spanning the Kicking Horse River. We will arrive and check-in to the iconic Fairmont Chateau Lake Louise. Surrounded by soaring mountain peaks, the majestic Victoria Glacier and a glistening emerald lake, our home for this evening will be one to remember. Enjoy a delicious group dinner this evening for the perfect end to an unforgettable day. (B,L,D)

WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 14

We will marvel at man's ingenuity as the train enters the Spiral Tunnels, bored through solid rock beneath a mountain over a century ago. We will arrive in Kamloops, our home for the evening, around 7:00 pm. We will be transferred to our hotel for the evening where you are free to explore the city or relax at the hotel.

THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 15

We will get an early start this morning as we head to the Kamloops Station to board our luxury train. On today's journey west, we will again see dramatic changes in scenery, from the desert-like environment of the Interior, through winding river canyons and pristine forests, to the Coast and Cascade Mountains and the lush green fields of the Fraser Valley. Highlights include the steep slopes and rock sheds along the Thompson River and the rushing waters of Hell's Gate, a narrow canyon where the volume of water rushing through is about three times greater than Niagara Falls. We will enjoy gourmet food and drink along the way before arriving in Vancouver in the early evening, our home for the next two nights. We will board our private transfer to the hotel and enjoy a free evening to explore this beautiful city. We have included admission to the Vancouver Lookout which gives you a 360 degree view of one of the most beautiful cities in the world. (B ,L)

FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 16

Enjoy a hot breakfast this morning before we head out for our sightseeing tour of Vancouver's spectacular North Shore with breathtaking views of the city, ocean and surrounding mountains. Highlights include a walk across the Capilano Suspension Bridge (450 ft long and 230 ft high) and a ride on the Grouse Mountain Skyride. We will finish the day with a special group farewell dinner.
