We will take in the splendor of Denali and the great Alaska Range from a spectacular vantage point on the Susitna River! The folklore, artifacts, and panoramic views combine to make this unique 20-mile Alaska river adventure unforgettable. This evening, we will head back to the lodge which offers the best of Alaska inside and out. Outside, you are at the doorstep of outdoor adventures.
